<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct and assist residents with activities of daily living and personal care, such as bathing, washing, bowel and bladder care, bed making, dressing, oral hygiene, skin and hair care etc.. • Ensure residents care needs are met according to personal services plan/ care plan • Ensure residents receives adequate nutrition according to individual care plan. • Observe, report and record changes in a resident's functional and cognitive behavior to the Director of Care. • Assist with ambulation using the proper equipment such as walker and cane/techniques as identified in the resident's care plan. • Assist and encourage residents to participate in social and recreational activities of their choice, as offered by the Lodge. • Assist with escorting services, if required, as assigned by the Director of Care. 			
We have both part time and casual on call positions. Due to the Single Site initiative during COVID19, applicants can only work at one designated Long Term Care or Assisted Living sites.
