

Infection Prevention and Control Requirements for COVID19 – Medical and social outings protocols	
Resident returning from Acute care.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Option 1: resident will get a COVID19 Swab before returning to Chalmers Lodge, the resident will then stay on room isolation until results are received. Option 2: resident does not get a COVID 19 swab, resident will be in self isolation for 14days.
Resident returning from Emergency Room	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> On return to the lodge: Resident will be screened, will wash/sanitize their hands and apply a mask. Resident will then be assisted or directed to remove their clothes, have a shower and wash their clothes. Resident will be allowed to be outside their room but they will need to wear a mask when they are in common areas for 14 day period. ER must be deemed Covid free for this to apply. If resident is not compliant with #1 then they will be subject to a 14day self isolation in their room.
Resident going to a medical appointment	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Resident will be asked to first arrange a remote visit, if the doctor insists on an in person visit, please report this to the DOC. When leaving to visit a doctor a resident must wash/sanitize their hands and be given a mask when exiting the building On return to the lodge: Resident will be screened, will wash/sanitize their hands, and apply a mask. Resident will then be assisted or directed to remove their clothes, have a shower and wash their clothes immediately. Resident will be allowed to be outside their room, but they will need to wear a mask when they are in common areas for 14 day period. If resident is not compliant with #2& #3 then they will be subject to a 14day self isolation in their room.
Residents going on social outings	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Resident will be asked to explore all options available and to try and limit their outings to essential outings. When leaving the Lodge a resident must wash/sanitize their hands and be given a mask when exiting the building.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Residents should always maintain safe physical distance and wear a non-medical mask when in enclosed spaces such as banks or stores where safe physical distances cannot be maintained. 4. Residents are not permitted to take public transit. Taxi's and transportation by family / friend are acceptable methods of transportation 5. On return to the lodge: Resident will be screened, will wash/sanitize their hands, and apply a mask. Resident will then be assisted or directed to remove their clothes, have a shower and wash their clothes immediately. Resident will be allowed to be outside their room, but they will need to wear a mask when they are in common areas for 14 day period. 6. If resident is not compliant with #2& #3 then they will be subject to a 14day self isolation in their room.
<p>Residents going on Temporary absence from the lodge (overnight leaves)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resident need to be aware that upon return from a temporary absence from the lodge will need to be in self isolation for 14 days. 2. When leaving the Lodge a resident must wash/sanitize their hands and be given a mask when exiting the building. 3. Residents should always maintain safe physical distance and wear a non-medical mask when in enclosed spaces such as banks or stores where safe physical distances cannot be maintained. 4. On return to the lodge: Resident will be screened, will wash/sanitize their hands, and apply a mask. Resident will then be assisted or directed to remove their clothes, have a shower and wash their clothes immediately 5. Residents will be required to undergo a 14day self isolation.

The lodge is responsible for the overall safety of all residents and reserves the right to impose a 14 day quarantine at its discretion when a residents leaves the premises.
